

The Great British Baking Tour In-Person

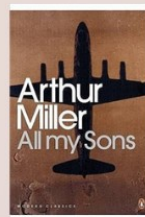

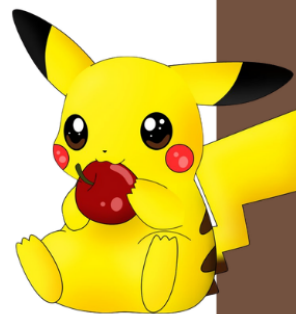
Our weekly storytimes resume in January. Keep an eye on our calendar for special events between now and then to supplement the storytime break!
